## Glass shop



At craft Village we visited an artisan glass shop as soon as we arrived at the store we entered the place where a gentleman with the technique of glass blowing created a penguin and a flower, there was a gigantic oven in which he put a piece of glass that was then heated and shaped and then decorated it with stones or minerals.
